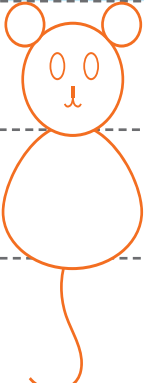
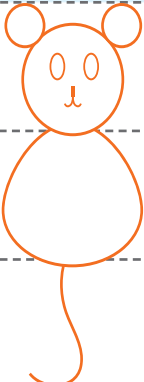
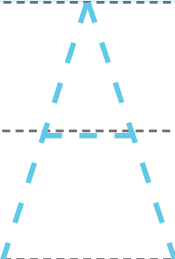
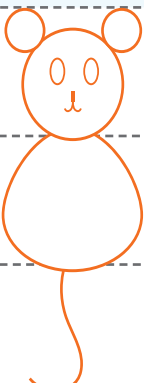
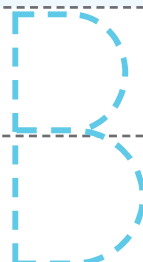


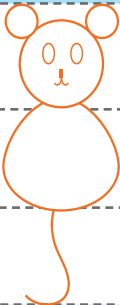
CAPITAL LETTERS

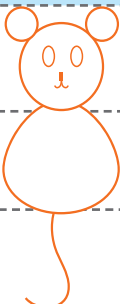


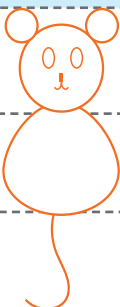



A simple line drawing of a mouse with large ears, a small tail, and a friendly expression.

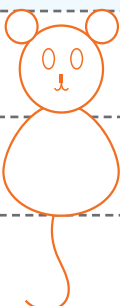
