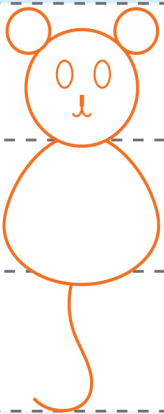


Full stops and commas

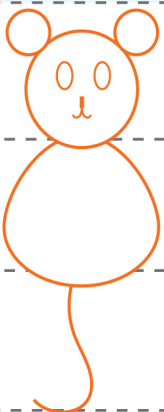
A full stop is something that is put at the end of a sentence to show that the sentence is finished. It is usually when we have finished a thought about something.

- Example:
- My friend's name is Bob.
 - I like cats.
 - That boy is very naughty.
 - We are in Grade 1.

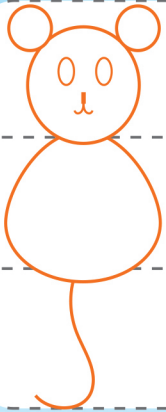

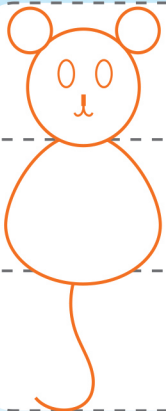

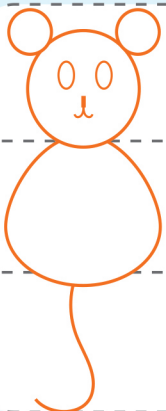
