

Repeated addition

Lerato loves addition. She wants to do some repeated addition sums. Help her find the answers. Remember the steps for solving the word problems.

- 1 3 monkeys picked bananas off the tree. Each monkey picked 3 bananas. How many bananas did they pick altogether?

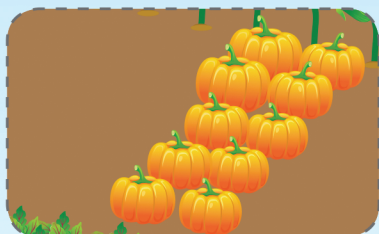


$$3 + 3 + 3 = 9$$

$$\text{or } 3 \times 3 = 9$$

9 bananas altogether.

- 2 Mrs. Maneli planted 5 rows of pumpkins. Each row had 2 pumpkins. How many pumpkins did she plant altogether?

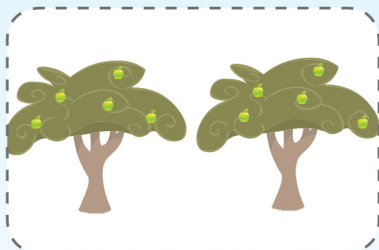


$$+ + + + =$$

$$\text{or } \times =$$

 pumpkins altogether.

- 3 Lerato went to pick some apples. There were 2 trees. Each tree had 5 apples. She picked all the apples. How many apples did she pick altogether?



$$+ =$$

$$\text{or } \times =$$

 apples altogether.



Remind learners of the steps for solving word problems. Explain to learners that repeated addition is the beginning of multiplication.
