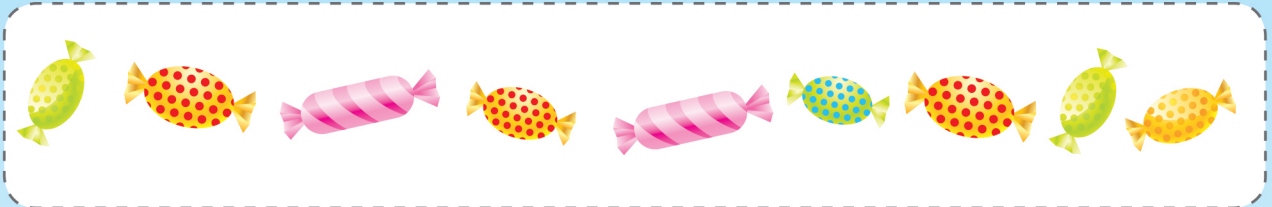


Sharing is caring

- 1 Share 9 sweets equally between 3 boys.

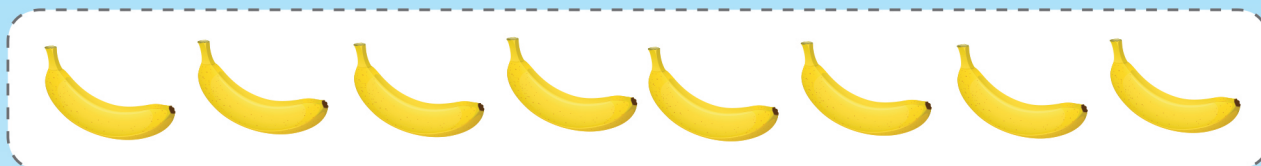


Each child got 3 sweets.

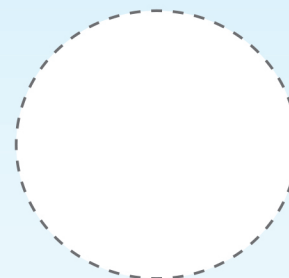
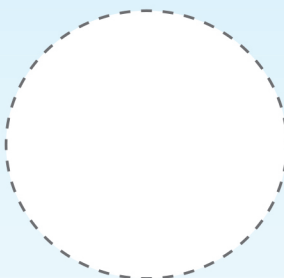
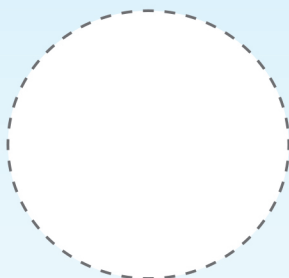
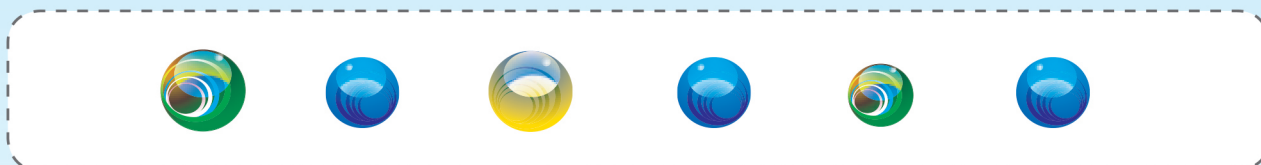
- 2 Gogo has 10 cupcakes. She wants to share them between 5 children. How many cupcakes do they each get?
