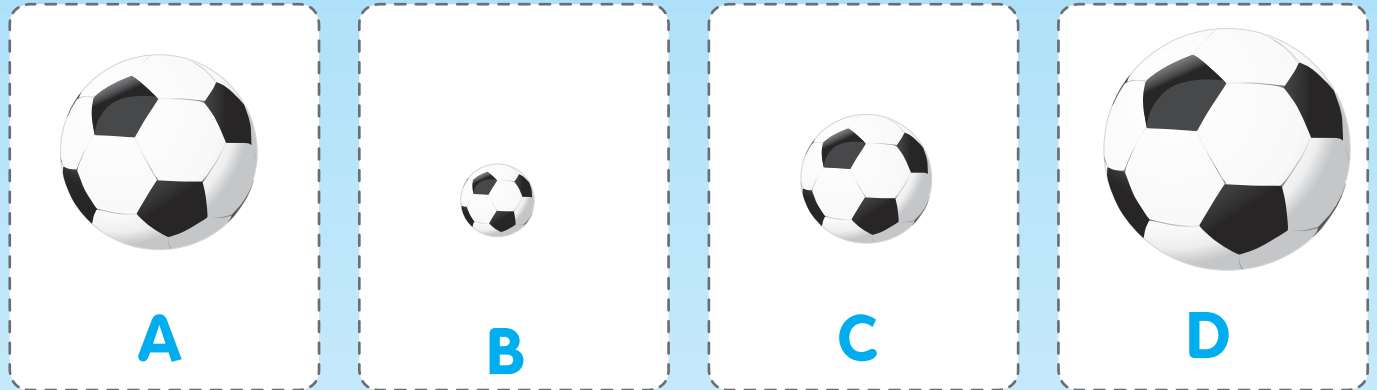


Space and shape

1 Lerato loves to play soccer with her brothers.



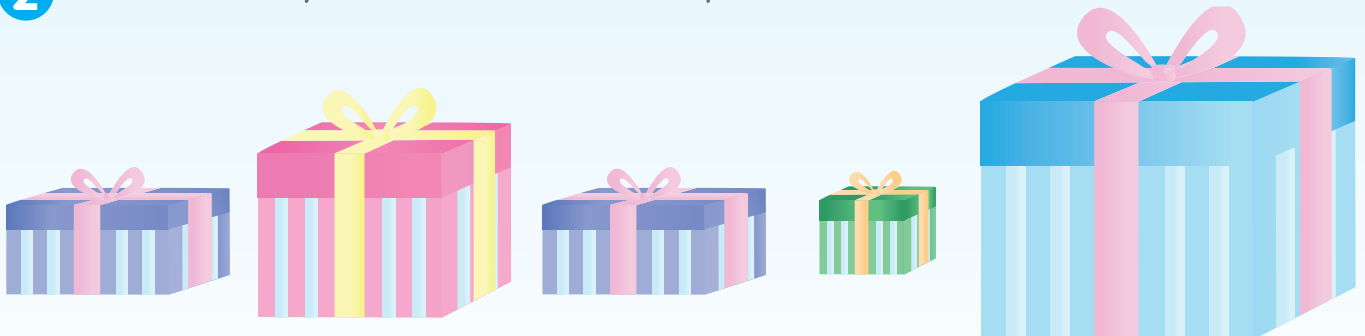
a Write the letters in order from the biggest ball to smallest ball:

For learners having difficulty grasping these concepts, use constant repetition and the manipulation of physical objects (balls/boxes) while emphasising the correct vocabulary.

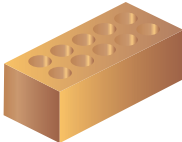
