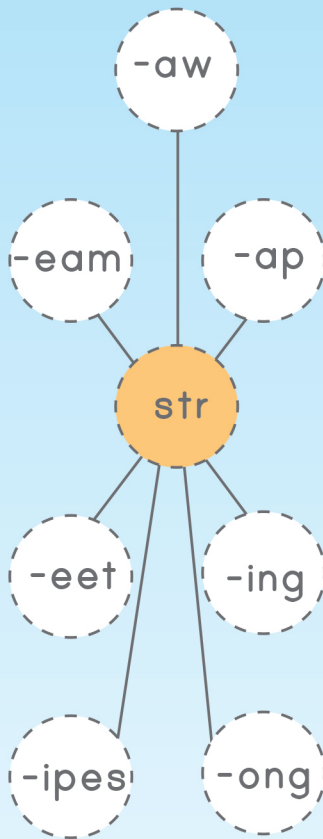


Consonant blend beginnings

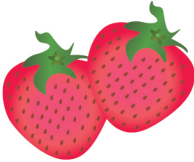
