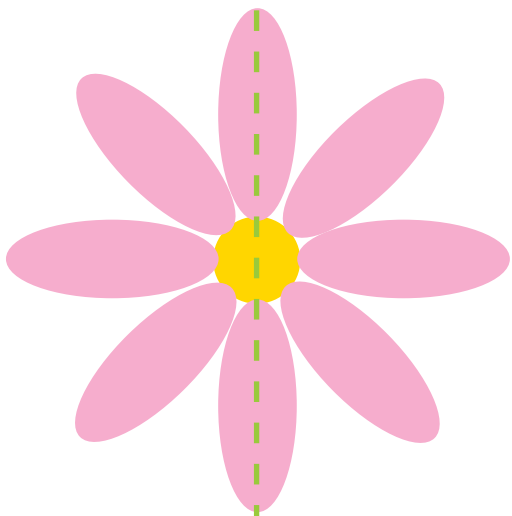
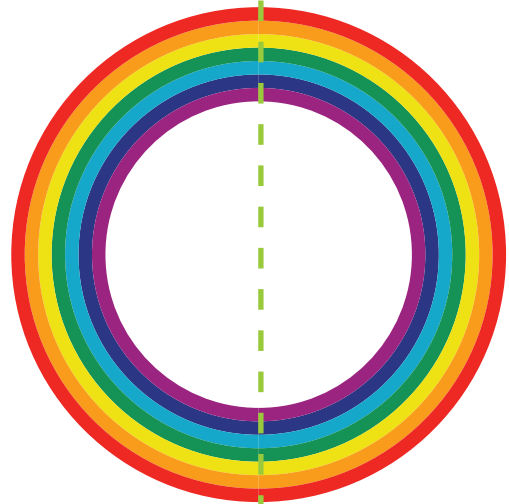


Symmetry

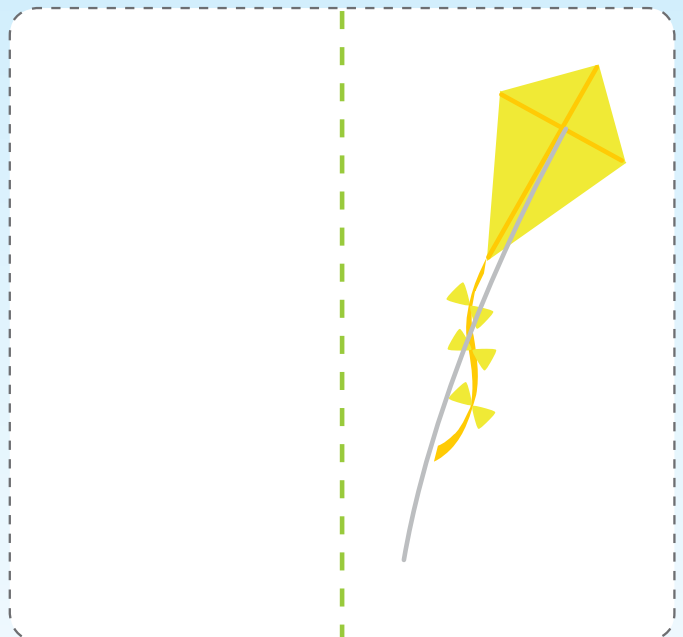
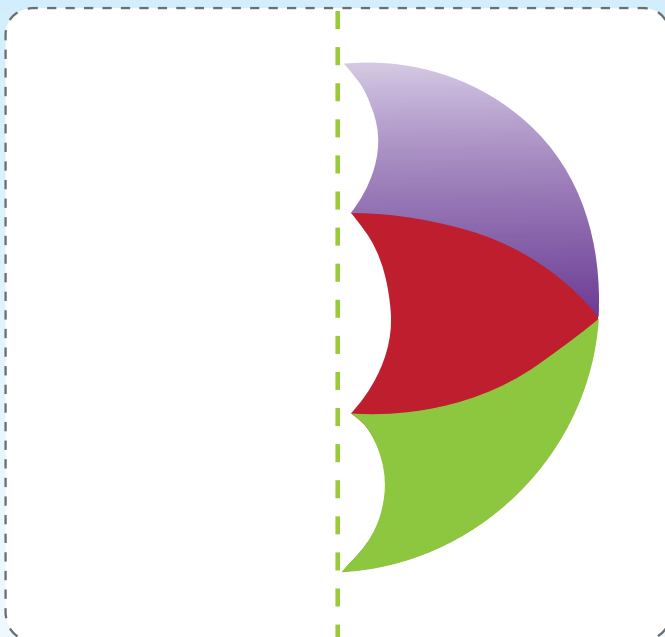
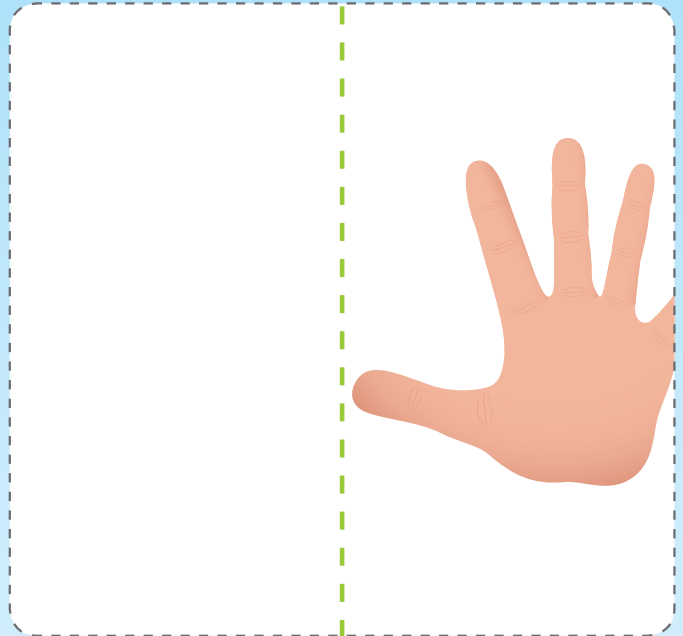
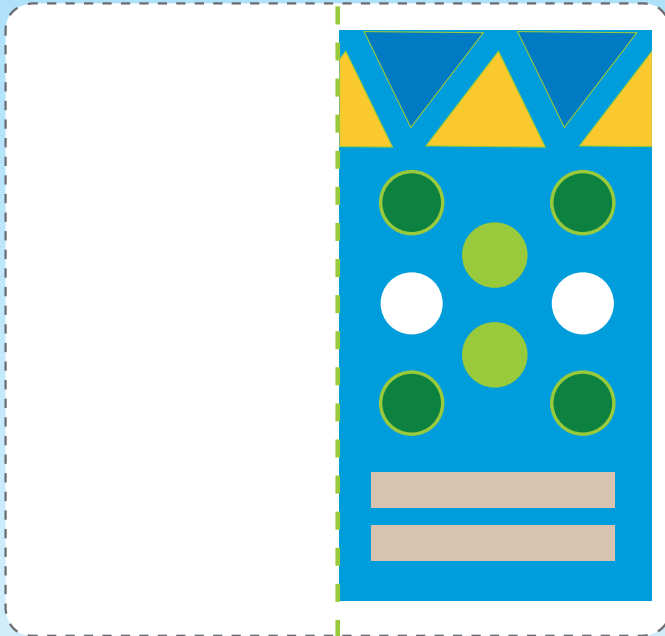
When something looks the same on both sides of an imaginary line, we say that it has **symmetry**. When something has symmetry, it is symmetrical.
