



## Addition

Lerato and Gogo are talking about how they do more difficult sums in different ways. Look at both of their ways and then decide which one you would like to use.



I have been taught this way because it helps me to see the number families I am working with.

$$\begin{array}{l} 234 + 152 \rightarrow 200 + 100 = 300 \\ 30 + 50 = 80 \\ 4 + 2 = 6 \end{array}$$

These families are then put together to get an answer of **386**.

I was taught to write each families in the correct column without breaking up.
