

Time

Help Gogo to put the numbers on the clock face. Three have been done for you.



This is important when we tell the time. When the minute hand reaches the 3, we say quarter past. When the minute hand reaches the 6, we say half past. When the minute hand reaches the 9, we say quarter to. This is easier than saying three quarters past.

How many hands are there on a clock?

How many minutes are there in an hour?

How many minutes are there between each of the numbers?

Draw a line joining the 12 and the 6.

Draw a line joining the 9 and the 3.

What has the clock been divided into?



Look at these times in words and draw the hands in on the clocks at the correct places. The first one has been done for you.
