



Place value



I will help you with the big numbers. Look at what I am doing. 3 columns that each have a name. H = hundreds, T = tens and U = units. Say the number to figure out.

Lerato uses Gogo's clues to put the numbers in the correct columns. Look at this number: **376**

Lerato says the number - three hundred and seventy-six

How many hundreds are there?

3 - Gogo reminds her to put the **3** here -----▶ **3**

How many groups of ten are there?

7 groups so put the **7** here -----▶ **7**

How many units (or ones) are there?

The last number that is heard is **6** - put it here -----▶ **6**
