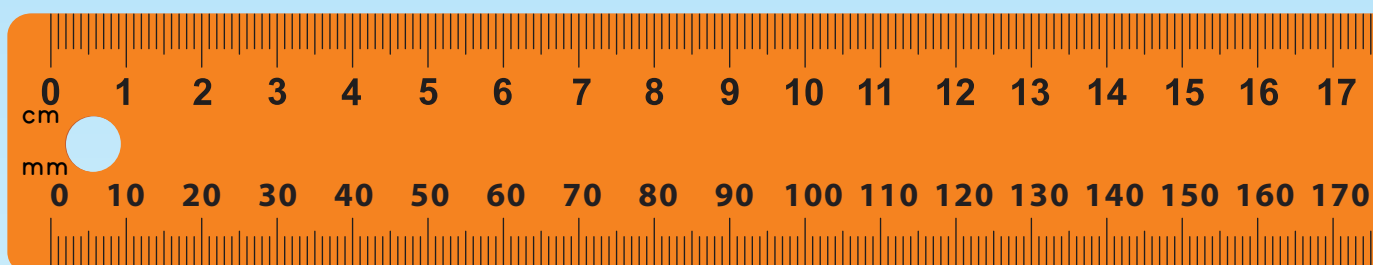




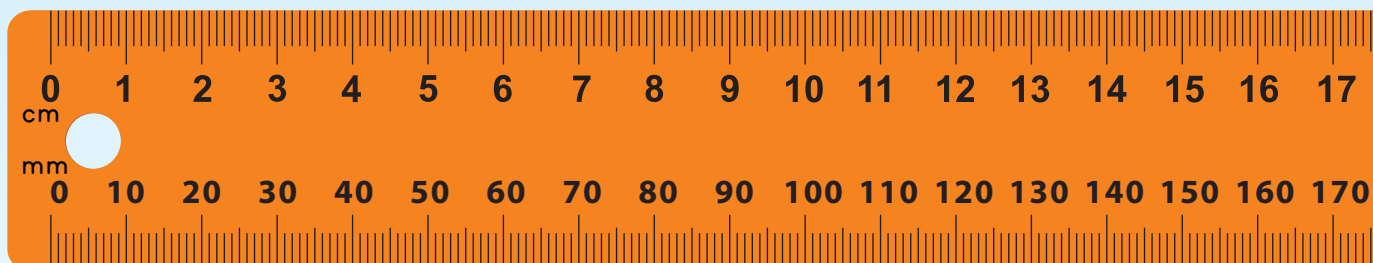
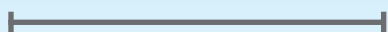
Estimate, measure and record length

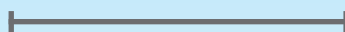

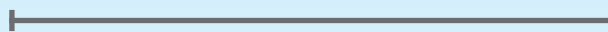

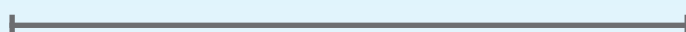

Estimate, measure and record length

- i Estimate how long the board is. (Remember it is longer than one ruler!) cm
