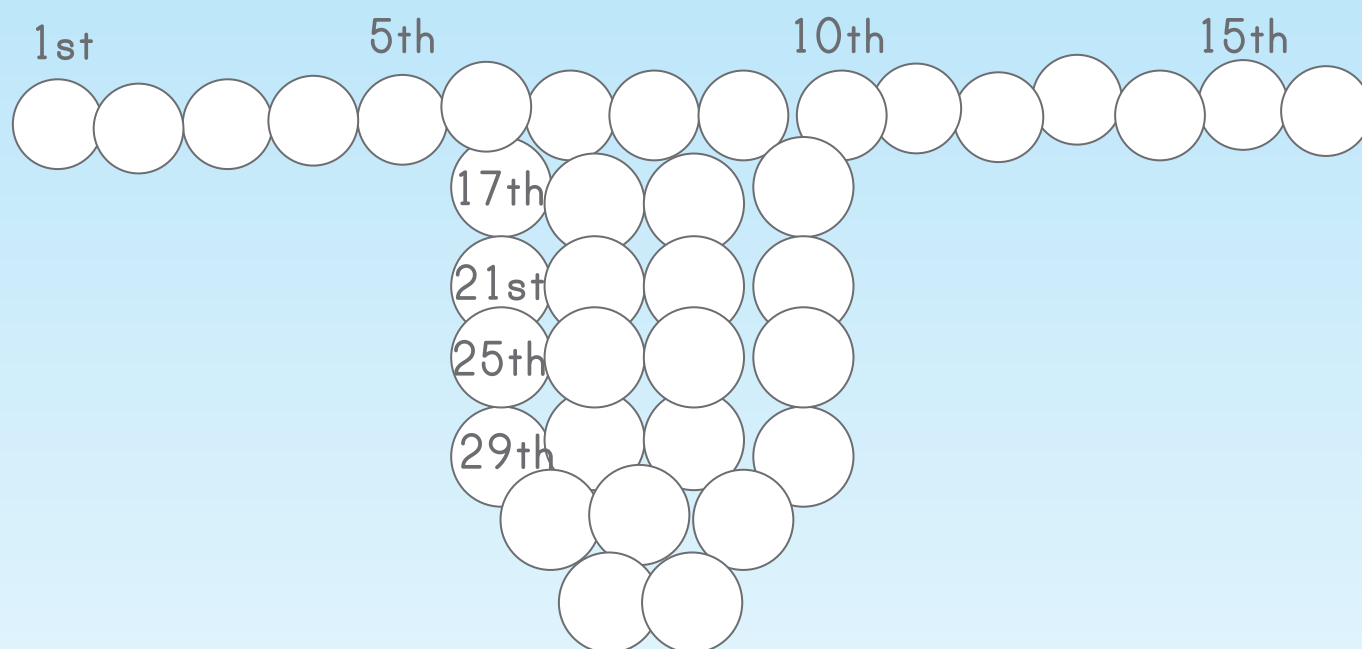




Ordinal numbers

Lerato is stringing beads to make a necklace to go with her new outfit. Follow the instructions and colour the beads in to find out what pattern she is making.



- In the first row, the first, fifteenth and sixteenth beads are orange.
- In the first row, the second, thirteenth and fourteenth beads are red.
- In the first row, the third, fourth, eleventh and twelfth beads are green.
- In the first row, the fifth, sixth, ninth and tenth beads are blue.
- The seventeenth, twenty-first and twenty-fifth are orange. The beads next to these are red.



- f** The twenty-ninth and the next three beads are green.
- g** The last five beads are blue.
- h** Beads 19, 23 and 27 are orange, with the beads to the right of them being red.
