



Multiplication

Multiplication is the same as repeated addition.

Ask yourself how many times do you see a number.

$$2 + 2 + 2 + 2 + 2$$

How many times do you see the number 2? So, the calculation will be $5 \times 2 = 10$

in the same way, $5 + 5 + 5$ is the same as

$$3 \times \text{ } = 15$$

Now do these multiplication sums:

$$3 \times 2 = \text{ }$$

$$10 \times 3 = \text{ }$$

$$5 \times 5 = \text{ }$$

$$1 \times 2 = \text{ }$$

$$12 \times 1 = \text{ }$$
