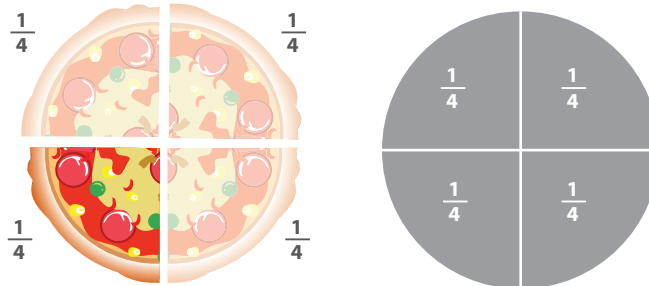

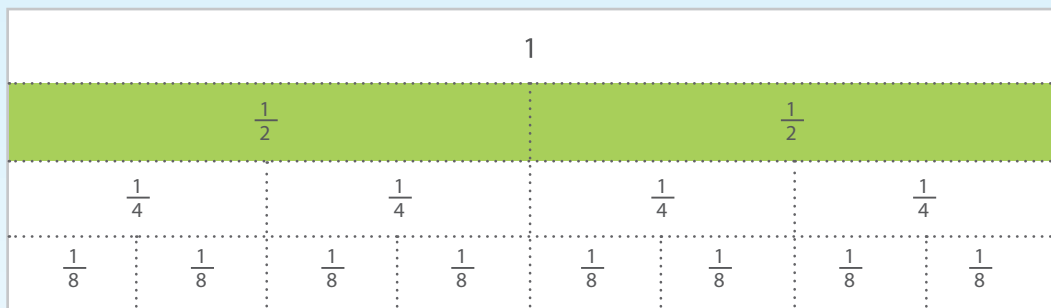
Note
