When writing a paragraph that describes something, remember to:

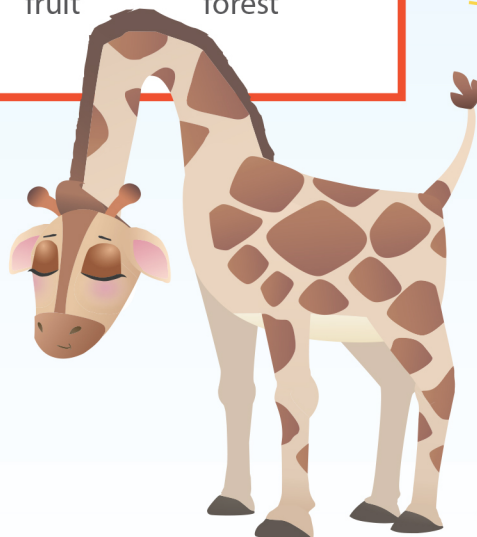
- write in full sentences
